## **High Surf Advisory in effect this afternoon through Saturday**

HIGH SURF ADVISORY FOR ORANGE COUNTY COAST  
THIS AFTERNOON THROUGH SATURDAY.

SOUTHERLY SWELLS...GENERATED BY TROPICAL CYCLONE  
EUGENE WILL PEAK AROUND 6 FEET THIS EVENING AND  
THEN CONTINUE AT LEAST 5 FEET THROUGH  
SATURDAY AFTERNOON.

THIS WILL CAUSE OCCASIONAL BREAKERS TO 10 FEET ON  
SOUTH FACING BEACHES AND MAKE  
NORMALLY SHELTERED BAY AND HARBOR ENTRANCES  
DIFFICULT TO ENTER OR EXIT.

ABOVE NORMAL SURF HEIGHTS WILL CONTINUE  
SATURDAY NIGHT THROUGH MONDAY AS THE  
SOUTHERLY SWELLS SLOWLY SUBSIDE.
