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FISCAL YEAR 2016/2017 PLAN CHECK FEE SCHEDULE FOR PUBLIC POOLS

Plan check fees are established to offset the expenses of enforcing State statutes relating to public health and must be paid at the time the plans are submitted for review. New Construction fees are assessed per body of water and based on the type of pool and volume. Remodel fees are assessed per body of water and based on the number of remodel activities proposed for evaluation. Additional fees, based on a rate of \$85.00 per hour, are required for third or greater preliminary inspections or reviews, and second or greater final follow-up inspections. All checks are to be made payable to **“Orange County Health Care Agency.”**

If remodeling a public pool please see the informational bulletin on *Remodels to Public Pools or Ancillary Areas*. Examples of independent remodel activities include, but are not limited to resurfacing, main drain retrofits, fence/gate replacement (not repair), new recirculation equipment units (recirculation/jet pumps, filters, chemical feeders, skimmers), new deck/ coping, or shower/restroom re-finishes.

- Remodels limited to shell resurfacing may be evaluated for approval without plan review by completing the *Public Pool Resurface Request* form. All other minor remodels require plan submittal to obtain approval. Pool approved for resurfaced still require inspections and written approval prior to placing the pool back into use.
- If there are multiple pools in a single enclosure, a modification to an ancillary facility such as the deck, fence, or restroom/shower areas is considered a single activity.
- The replacement of a single ‘like for like’ component of the recirculation equipment, such as a pump, filter, or chlorinator will require approval by your district environmental health specialist. This will require equipment specification submittal but may not require the submittal of plans. For further information please consult your district environmental health specialist.
- Complete above-ground recirculation equipment remodels will require the submittal of plans and specifications.
