

**Clients' Profiles Fact Sheet
Adults Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 2,003,084 adults between the ages of 18 and 64*. The population increased by 1.2% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2013/14 TO 2016/17, and a further increase of 0.6% is projected from FY 2016/17 to 2019/20. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 5 adult residents of the County in June 2017.
