

**Clients' Profiles Fact Sheet
Seniors Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 459,029 seniors age 65 and older*. The population increased by 12.3% from Fiscal Year (FY) 2013/14 to 2016/17, and a further increase of 12.3% is projected from FY 2016/17 to 2019/20. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 6 senior residents of the County in June 2017.
