Free Water-Saving Hose Nozzles Available

New regulations regarding potable water usage were approved on July 15, 2014 by California's State Water Resources Control Board.

The new regulations prohibit:

The use of a hose that dispenses potable water to wash a motor vehicle (or vessel), except where the hose is fitted with a shut-off nozzle or device attached to it that causes it to cease dispensing water immediately when not in use.

As part of our ongoing water quality and water conservation efforts, and in cooperation with South Coast Water District, OC Dana Point Harbor is pleased to provide complimentary water-saving hose nozzles to Boat Slip Licensees.

Boaters may pick up a nozzle at the East & West Basin Marina Offices.

Supplies are limited so please call in advance to check availability.

Only one nozzle will be given to each Boat Slip Licensee on a first-come, first-served basis.
