**Saturday, January 16th -
Friday, January 22nd**

The National Weather Service has issued a Hazardous Weather Outlook for Orange County coastal areas, and coastal waters from San Mateo Point to the Mexican border and out 30 NM.

A series of storms will bring periods of locally heavy rain and strong winds beginning Sunday and extending into next week. Over the coastal waters, gale force or higher winds are expected to precede each storm.

Please exercise extreme caution during all boating activities in the coming week and take the time to properly secure your vessel while in its slip.
