Existing Landfill Odor Control Measures

Landscaped Berm



A landscape berm has been installed to reduce off-site migrating odors and for aesthetic enhancement.

Trees and Shrubs



Tall trees and shrubs have been added to the berm; additional tall trees and shrubs will be added in the future.

Organic Material




Biosolids are not accepted at the landfill after 2 p.m.

Organic Material



Processed green material is not accepted at the landfill after 11 a.m.

Water Misting System



A misting system has been installed to help reduce odors.

Covered Waste Material



Soil tarps are being used to cover solid waste materials.

Water Misting System



Two additional misting systems will be installed.

Odor Neutralizing Misting System



An odor neutralizing agent will be used as warranted.

Wind Deflection Fences



Wind deflection fences will be installed at the landfill working face.
