## **Coroner Mass Fatality Management**

The 8-hour POST certified Coroner Mass Fatality Management Course is designed for coroner/medical examiner and law enforcement supervisory and management personnel tasked with fatality management functions during a mass fatality incident. This course reviews basic principles of mass fatality response and management, mass fatality planning, availability of resources for large-scale response, coordination with mutual aid assets, and staff crisis management. The course culminates in a Mass Fatality Incident Management Tabletop Exercise.

Coroner Mass Fatality Management is the second/supervisory level course in the Coroner Mass Fatality training series, and it is recommended that the participants have previously completed the Coroner Mass Fatality Awareness Course.
