Effective Interviewing in a Death Investigation

Effective Interviewing in a Death Investigation is a 24-hour POST Plan IV certified course for investigators entering the field of Death Investigation, or those wishing to learn more about the many facets of interviewing in death investigations. This course focuses on the core duties, skills, and knowledge that a newly appointed deputy coroner or law enforcement officer will need to succeed in obtaining the necessary information to certify the manner of death on a death certificate. It provides students with concepts of understanding effective communication, building rapport with witnesses to enhance the exchange of sensitive information, the cognitive interview in a death investigation, understanding how religion and culture can affect people during the investigation, and when Miranda is necessary for an interview to continue. *This is not an advanced Interview & Interrogation Course.
