- 1. CONTRACTOR shall maintain in force at all times during the term of Certification a policy, or policies, of insurance covering its operations as above.
- 2. All insurance policies, except Professional Liability, Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability, shall be endorsed to contain the following clauses. Endorsements shall accompany the certificate of insurance:
 - "The County of Orange is included as an additional insured with respect to the operations of the named insured"
 - "It is agreed that any insurance maintained by the County of Orange shall apply in excess of, and not contribute with, insurance provided by this policy."

County of Orange shall be given thirty (30) days written notice in the event of cancellation. - (*footnote 1) Coverage for Automobile Insurance is required only if the Sober Living Facility allows residents to operate vehicles owned by the facility, or the facility transports residents in a facility owned vehicle. If no vehicle and/or transportation is provided this insurance is NOT required.
- (*footnote 2) Professional Liability Insurance is required only if treatment is provided at the facility by facility staff. If treatment is not provided by facility staff this insurance coverage is NOT required.
